

Based upon the foregoing and the other evidence presented, the COURT ORDERS that:

1. THE GUIDELINES WERE:

- Followed.
- Not followed - see the Court Order for cause.

2. BASE CHILD SUPPORT: If the Guidelines were followed, Line 13d is Obligor's Base Child Support Amount. If the Guidelines were not followed, see the Court Order for Obligor's Base Child Support Amount. **Obligor's Base Child Support remains in effect until modified by Court Order.**

3. CHILD HEALTH INSURANCE PREMIUMS: Each party who incurs Child Health Insurance Premiums on Line 9 is **ORDERED** to provide the other party with timely documentation of any change in the amount of such costs. If the amount(s) of Child Health Insurance Premiums on Line 9 change, such change may be a basis for a Court Ordered modification of Base Child Support.

4. HEALTH CARE EXPENSES: As to all reasonable and necessary medical, dental, orthodontic, optometric, psychological, or any other physical or mental health expenses of the child incurred by either parent and not reimbursed by insurance, **THE COURT ORDERS THAT:**

- Said health expenses are ordered to be shared by the parties in the same proportion as Adjusted Gross Income shown on Line 5.
- Said health expenses are not ordered to be shared by the parties in the same proportion as Adjusted Gross Income shown on Line 5. See the Court Order for detail.

If said health expenses are ordered shared between the parties, the parent incurring the expense shall timely submit documentation of the expense to the other parent and that parent is Ordered to pay his/her share of the same to the other parent within thirty (30) days of receipt of documentation of the expense. **If one party is ordered to pay 100% of the health expenses and the other party incurs such expense,** the same requirements shall apply, i.e., the party having no share of the expense shall timely submit documentation of the health care expense to the party having 100% of such expense, and, within thirty (30) days of the receipt of such documentation, the party having 100% of such expense shall reimburse the other party for the incurred expense.

5. CHILD CARE: If the amounts of Child Care Expense in Line 11 change, the Obligor's Net Monthly Payment to Obligee shall automatically be recalculated to reflect the changed amounts. Each party who incurs child care expense related to employment, employment search, or education or training to enhance employment income is **ORDERED** to provide the other party with timely documentation of any change in the amount of the child care costs. The party incurring such costs is **ORDERED** to provide the other party with documentation reflecting such costs when requested, but not more often than monthly.

6. OTHER ORDERS: In addition to the foregoing orders:

- Other orders are in the Court Order concerning other child-related expenses. See the Court Order for detail.
- Child support will prospectively change. See the Court Order for detail.
